
Overview

- The original 2019 OurCounty Plan set a bold vision for the future of the County, and the refresh will do the same, balancing co-equal values of environment, equity, and economy.
- The CSO is preparing to launch the Climate Resilience Initiative and will use the OurCounty
 refresh as an opportunity to articulate a vision for climate resilience in the region and establish
 short-term priorities and metrics.
- The OurCounty Update process will utilize equity-driven engagement, research, and data analysis processes to assess progress over the last five years and outline a comprehensive roadmap for the County to achieve its sustainability goals.

How have we progressed?




More than 80% of Priority

are Achieved or On Track

Select Achievements from the County:

- 110 acres new parkland created in the unincorporated areas of LA County
- Board adoption of the Parks Needs Assessment Plus (PNA+) and Community Forest Management Plan (CFMP)
- Increase in CalFresh participation rate and creation of LA County Office of Food Equity
- Composting expanded to nearly all households
- Development of the Food Equity Roundtable Strategic Plan


Overall Progress




